CODE OF ETHICS

The Board of Directors agrees to adhere to and follow the following code of ethics:

- 1. As a member of the Alaska Rural Water Association Board of Directors I will:
 - A. Listen carefully to my fellow board members, and the membership I serve.
 - B. Respect the opinion of my fellow Board members.
 - C. Respect and support the majority decisions of the Board.
 - D. Recognize that all authority is vested in the Board when it meets in legal session and not with individual Board members.
 - E. Keep well-informed of develops that are relevant to issues that may come before the Board.
 - F. Participate actively in Board meetings and actions.
 - G. Call to the attention of the Board any issues that I believe will have an adverse effect on the Association.
 - H. Attempt to respond to the needs of the members of the Association.
 - I. Refer member or staff complaints to the proper level on the chain of command.
 - J. Recognize that the Board member's job is to ensure that the Association is well-managed, not to manage the Association.
 - K. Vote to hire the best possible person to manage the Association.
 - L. Represent all members of the Association and not a particular geographic area or special interest group.
 - M. Consider myself a "trustee" of the Association and do my best to ensure that the Association is well maintained, financially secure, growing and always operating in the best interest of the membership.
 - N. Always work to learn more about the Board member's job and how to do the job better.
 - O. Declare any conflicts of interest between my personal life and my position on the Association Board, and avoid voting on issues that appear to be a conflict of interest.
- 2. As a member of the ARWA Board I will not:
 - A. Be disrespectful, in or outside of the Board meeting, of fellow Board members or their opinions.
 - B. Use the Association or any part of the organization for my personal advantage or the personal advantage of my friends or relatives.
 - C. Discuss the confidential proceedings of the Board outside the Board meeting.
 - D. Promise prior to a meeting how I will vote on any issue in the meeting
 - E. Interfere with the duties of the Executive Director or undermine the Executive Director's authority.
